For a 12-core optical fiber cable, each fiber is assigned a unique color to ensure correct identification during splicing, termination, and maintenance. The TIA-598-C and BELLCORE standards define the sequence as follows:

- Blue
- Orange
- Green
- Brown
- Gray (Slate)
- White
- Red
- Black
- Yellow
- Violet
- Rose
- Aqua This sequence is applied consistently across single loose tubes or bundles, allowing technicians to quickly identify fibers without confusion .
