

# 144 fiber optic cable cannot be stripped



## Overview

That is, you cannot strip the above cable in one “go”, the layers must be stripped progressively. (there is a slight exception with the Buffers, we'll elaborate below). Damage to the fiber during stripping may not always cause the fiber to break immediately. It is very possible for a damaged fiber to remain unbroken during the production line processing.
