Preparation and Planning

Ensure conduit space allows for future expansion, typically 25–40% extra capacity. Select the appropriate fiber type (single-mode for long distances, multi-mode for shorter distances) and ensure compatibility with your network equipment and patch panels .

Tools and Materials

Essential tools and materials include:

- Fiber cleaver for precise cutting of fiber strands
- Fusion splicer for permanent fiber joining
- LC, SC, or MPO connector kits depending on your patch panel and device ports
- Safety equipment such as gloves and safety glasses to protect against glass shards
- Cable management accessories like velcro straps and patch panels to organize fibers
