To prevent fiber stretching and enhance mechanical resilience, optical cables incorporate strengthening fibers such as aramid yarn (Kevlar) or FRP (fiber-reinforced plastic) rods. These materials absorb tensile forces during installation and operation, maintaining the integrity of the optical path .
