

Cable joints installed inside cable trays



Article Overview

Cable joints should generally not be installed inside cable trays unless specifically designed for tray use and properly protected.

NEC and Safety Considerations

The National Electrical Code (NEC) governs cable tray installations under Article 392, emphasizing safety, grounding, and proper cable management . Cable trays are intended to support and route cables efficiently, but they are not designed to provide mechanical protection for cable joints. Installing joints inside trays can create risks such as physical damage, overheating, and difficulty in inspection or maintenance .

Mechanical and Thermal Concerns

Cable joints often increase the cable diameter and may have insulating or metallic components that can interfere with tray fill limits and airflow. Overfilling trays or placing bulky joints inside can lead to heat buildup, restricted airflow, and potential code violations . Additionally, joints may be more susceptible to mechanical stress from tray vibrations or cable movement, which can compromise electrical continuity and safety.

Recommended Practices

- Use tray-rated splice kits: If joints must be within a tray, only use joints specifically rated for tray installation and environmental conditions.
- Provide mechanical protection: Enclose joints in protective covers or boxes to pre...
