Electrical cable trays are typically positioned above instrumentation trays, with proper spacing and separation to minimize interference and ensure safety.

Layering Principles

Electrical on Top, Instrumentation Below: In most industrial and commercial installations, power and high-current cables are placed on the upper trays, while low-voltage instrumentation and control cables are routed on lower trays. This arrangement reduces the risk of electromagnetic interference (EMI) from power cables affecting sensitive signal cables . **Layered Separation:** Strong current and high-voltage cables should be physically separated from low-current, low-voltage instrumentation cables. This layered approach preserves signal integrity and reduces maintenance issues .

Spacing and Segregation

Minimum Vertical and Horizontal Distance: Industry standards recommend maintaining at least 300 mm (12 inches) between power and control trays to minimize EMI. Where space constraints exist, metal partitions or dividers can be used to separate the layers and prevent interference . **Tray Height Considerations:** When stacking multiple trays, ensure that the vertical clearance allows for cable bending, maintenance access, and future expansion. Proper support systems should prevent sagging and maintain cable integrity .
