

Cable trays for wires and cables passing through walls

Cable trays passing through walls require proper support, firestopping, and organized wiring to ensure safety, compliance, and maintainability.

Wall Penetration and Firestopping

When cable trays pass through walls or slabs, it is essential to seal openings with firestopping materials to prevent fire spread and maintain structural integrity. Begin by reserving openings for the trays, then install busways or conduits as needed. Use fire-rated boards, firestop packs, firestop mastic, or mineral wool to fill gaps around cables and trays. Ensure gaps do not exceed 1 cm² and packing thickness is at least 24 cm. For large openings, a fire-resistant backing plate should be installed before sealing. Cover plates should be square, evenly painted, and tightly fitted to prevent voids or cracks .

Cable Tray Installation and Support

Select the appropriate tray type based on cable type and environment: ladder trays for power cables, ventilated troughs for control or instrumentation cables, and FRP trays for corrosive or high-moisture areas. Wall-mounted trays should use cantilever brackets, securely anchored and levelled. Ceiling or overhead runs may use trapeze hangers. Support spacing typically ranges from 1.5 to 3 meters depending on tray type and load
