

Calculation of Optical Cable Length Loss



Article Overview

Optical cable length loss is calculated by summing the fiber attenuation, connector loss, and splice loss along the link, expressed in decibels (dB).

Step-by-Step Calculation

- Determine Cable Attenuation
 - Cable attenuation depends on the fiber type and operating wavelength.
 - Formula: Cable Attenuation (dB) = Fiber Length (km) × Attenuation Coefficient (dB/km)
 - Example: For a 10 km single-mode fiber at 1310 nm with 0.5 dB/km attenuation, the cable loss is $10 \times 0.5 = 5$ dB .
- Calculate Connector Loss
 - Each connector introduces a small loss, typically 0.3-0.5 dB.
 - Formula: Connector Loss (dB) = Number of Connectors × Loss per Connector
 - Example: 2 connectors with 0.5 dB each result in $2 \times 0.5 = 1$ dB loss .
- Calculate Splice Loss
 - Splices also contribute to signal loss, usually 0.1-0.3 dB per splice.
 - Formula: Splice Loss (dB) = Number of Splices × Loss per Splice
 - Example: 1 splice with 0.2 dB loss results in 0.2 dB .
- Sum All Losses
 - Total Link Loss = Cable Attenuation + Connector Loss + Splice Loss + any additional component losses (e.g., splitters, couplers)
 - Example: 5 dB (cable) + 1 dB (connectors) + 0.2 dB (splice) = 6.2 dB total loss
