Multimode fiber, in contrast, has a larger core (50–62.5 μm) that supports multiple light modes, making it suitable for short-distance applications but prone to modal dispersion. Dual-mode fiber typically refers to a fiber cable that can support both single-mode and multimode transceivers, but in practice, it is often optimized for multimode operation.

Compatibility Considerations

While dual-mode fiber may physically accept single-mode transceivers, using it as single-mode fiber introduces several challenges:

- **Core mismatch:** Single-mode transceivers are designed for a narrow core. If the dual-mode fiber has a larger core, light may spread into multiple modes, causing signal distortion and attenuation.
- **Modal dispersion:** The larger core of dual-mode fiber allows multiple light paths, which can interfere with the single-mode signal, reducing effective transmission distance.
