

Changing the zone on a fiber optic switch



Article Overview

To change a zone on a Fibre Channel switch, you modify the zone configuration within a zone set and then activate the updated zone set to apply changes.

Understanding Fibre Channel Zoning

Fibre Channel zoning allows you to control which initiators (hosts) can communicate with which targets (storage devices) within a SAN fabric. Zones can be based on physical switch ports (port zoning) or WWNs (World Wide Names) of devices (WWN zoning). Port zoning is simpler but less flexible, while WWN zoning is more resilient to changes in the SAN topology, such as moving devices or replacing cables . A zone set is a collection of zones, and only one zone set can be active at a time. Changes to zones are not applied until the zone set is activated, ensuring that modifications do not disrupt ongoing traffic until explicitly enforced .

Steps to Change a Zone

- Access the Switch: Connect to the switch using a terminal client (e.g., PuTTY) or management interface. Ensure you have administrative privileges .
- Identify the Zone Set: Determine which zone set is currently active. You can only modify zones within a zone set.
- Modify the Zone:
 - Add or remove members: For port zoning, assign or remove ports; for WWN zoning, add or remove device WWNs.
 - Create a new zone if needed: You can create a new zone and include it in the zone set....
