

Check if the optical module is working properly with Cisco



Overview

When optical modules operate on a switch, it is usually necessary to read the module's internal information to understand its working status—such as connection status and real-time metrics like optical power and temperature. Additionally, identifying module information helps detect coding. This guide gives a practical, CLI-focused workflow for checking SFP health and diagnostics on Cisco switches, shows the exact commands you'll use, explains what the numbers mean, and compares OEM (Cisco) vs third-party modules so you can pick the right SFP module supplier for reliability and cost. An important factor is to make sure that Cisco-compatible transceivers are fully compatible with your Cisco switch. Steps described here will be based on CISCO NX-OS. First step would be to know your switch or router and what kind of transceivers. Monitoring the optical power of SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable) modules is a critical step in maintaining stable network links. Even if an interface appears up, degraded Tx/Rx levels can cause intermittent flapping, packet loss, or err-disabled states. Checking optical power helps pinpoint issues.
