Key International Standards

ITU-T Recommendations provide global guidance on optical fiber characteristics and network deployment. For example, ITU-T G.652 defines single-mode fiber for general-purpose installations, G.655 specifies non-zero dispersion-shifted fibers for DWDM systems, and G.657 covers bend-insensitive fibers suitable for tight installations . These standards ensure compatibility, performance, and reliability across networks. IEC Standards such as IEC 60793 and IEC 60794 classify fiber and cable types, including mechanical, optical, and environmental specifications. IEC TR 62263:2024 addresses all-dielectric self-supporting (ADSS) cables and associated electrical hazards, providing guidance for safe aerial installations . TIA and ISO/IEC Standards (e.g., TIA-568.3-D, ISO/IEC 11801) focus on structured cabling systems, defining installation practices, performance requirements, and testing procedures for enterprise and premises networks .
