

Color of fiber optic cable protective tube



Article Overview

Fiber optic protection tube colors indicate the type of fiber inside, with yellow for single-mode, orange for multimode, and blue for polarization-maintaining fibers.

Standard Color Coding

Fiber optic protection tubes, also known as furcation tubing, are color-coded to help technicians quickly identify the type of fiber and ensure proper handling:

- Yellow: Single-mode fiber (OS1/OS2), typically with a 9μm core for long-distance, high-speed transmission using laser sources .
- Orange: Multimode fiber (OM1/OM2), commonly used for shorter-distance applications with LED or laser sources .
- Aqua: Laser-optimized multimode fiber (OM3/OM4), often used in high-speed data centers .
- Blue: Polarization-maintaining fiber, used in specialized applications requiring stable polarization .
- Black: Provides light-blocking protection to prevent visible light from entering the fiber . Custom colors are sometimes used for organizational purposes or to differentiate fibers in high-density cables, but the above colors follow industry standards like TIA-598-C .

Additional Considerations

- Tube Material: Furcation tubing can be made from polyvinylidene fluoride (PVDF) for rigidity or placed inside stainless steel sleeves for extra protection against bendi...
