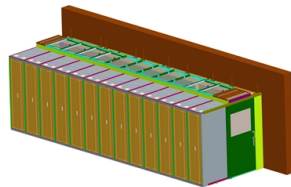


Connecting the PE wire to the cable tray



Article Overview

The PE wire should be securely bonded to the metallic cable tray using grounding clamps or connectors, ensuring a continuous low-impedance path to the main earthing system.

Purpose of PE Connection

The Protective Earth (PE) conductor provides a safe path for fault currents from exposed conductive parts to the main earthing terminal, preventing electric shock and equipment damage. In cable tray systems, the PE wire ensures that all metallic components are at the same potential, forming part of the main equipotential bonding system .

Connection Methods

- **Grounding Clamps:** Use tin- or zinc-plated grounding clamps to attach the PE wire to the cable tray. This provides both mechanical stability and electrical continuity under fault conditions .
- **Insulated Conductors:** If using aluminum trays, avoid bare copper PE wires to prevent electrolytic corrosion. Use insulated conductors and remove insulation only at bonding points .
- **Bonding Between Tray Sections:** For multi-section trays, bond the PE wire to each or alternate tray sections to maintain a continuous grounding path. This is recommended even if not strictly required by NEC .
- **Proximity to Live Conductors:** In TN or IT systems, install the PE wire close to the live conductors on the same tray to minimize inductive reactance in fault currents
