Optical modules typically use LC connectors, with SC and MPO/MTP connectors used in legacy or high-density applications.

Common Connector Types

LC (Lucent Connector) is the most widely used connector for modern SFP and optical modules due to its small form factor, high port density, and reliable performance in single-mode and multi-mode fiber networks . SC (Subscriber Connector) is primarily found in older or legacy networks. It is larger than LC and provides a push-pull coupling mechanism, suitable for installations where space is less constrained . MPO/MTP (Multi-Fiber Push-On / Multi-Fiber Termination Push-on) connectors are used for high-density cabling and backbone applications. They allow multiple fibers to be connected simultaneously, making them ideal for data centers and structured cabling systems .

Function and Interface

The connector on an optical module serves as the physical interface between the module and the fiber optic cable, ensuring precise alignment of the fiber core with the optical transmitter (TOSA) and receiver (ROSA) inside the module . This alignment is critical for minimizing insertion loss and maintaining signal quality. The connector type must match the fiber patch cable or be adapted using specialized adapters to ensure proper connectivity .
