

Construction process of optical cable junction box

The construction of optical cables at a junction box involves careful preparation, splicing, protection, and testing to ensure reliable fiber optic connectivity.

Preparation and Planning

Before installation, the optical cable and joint box must be inspected and prepared. This includes checking the cable for physical damage, verifying fiber characteristics, and reviewing the construction design drawings to determine the exact location, height, and orientation of the joint box on the tower or pole (typically 8-10 meters above ground for OPGW installations) to ensure accessibility and protection from environmental factors. The joint box should be made of durable, weather-resistant materials such as aluminum or stainless steel to withstand heat, corrosion, and mechanical stress.

Cable Laying and Routing

The optical cable is routed to the joint box according to the design plan. For overhead installations, the cable may be suspended on poles or towers using pre-laid steel wire ropes or conduits, while for underground installations, it is placed in trenches or ducts. Proper tension must be maintained to prevent sagging or abrasion, and pre-laying of conduits or support structures ensures smooth cable installation.
