Article Overview

Cable identification signs and labels on construction site power distribution boxes must follow standardized color codes, labeling methods, and placement requirements to ensure safety and code compliance.

Standards and Compliance

Identification of electrical systems must comply with ANSI A13.1, NFPA 70, NFPA 70E, OSHA 29 CFR 1910.144/145, and ANSI Z535.4 for safety signs and labels . Labels and signs should be durable, weather- and chemical-resistant, and, where applicable, UL 969 certified .

Cable and Conductor Identification

- Phase and Voltage Color Codes (600 V or less):
 - Phase A: Black
 - Phase B: Red
 - Phase C: Blue
 - Neutral: White
- High-Voltage or Emergency Systems: Use engraved plastic laminate or laminated plastic with white letters on red background for emergency circuits .
- Auxiliary Systems: Alarm, control, and signal wiring should be identified with color coding or wire/cable marking tape at terminations and intermediate points
