ADSS cables can carry single-mode fibers at 1310 or 1550 nm wavelengths, supporting circuits up to 100 km without repeaters, and can accommodate up to 864 fibers in a single cable.

Hollow-Core Fiber Technology

Hollow-core fibers (HCFs) replace the solid glass core of traditional fibers with an air-filled channel, allowing light to propagate at nearly the speed of light in vacuum ($\sim 3 \times 10^8$ m/s), reducing latency by 30–50% compared to conventional fibers. HCFs also minimize nonlinear effects such as Kerr, Brillouin, and Raman scattering, and can support a broader low-loss optical spectrum, potentially extending from visible wavelengths to 2100 nm. This makes hollow-core fiber particularly advantageous for high-speed, low-latency applications like AI data center interconnections and real-time cloud computing
