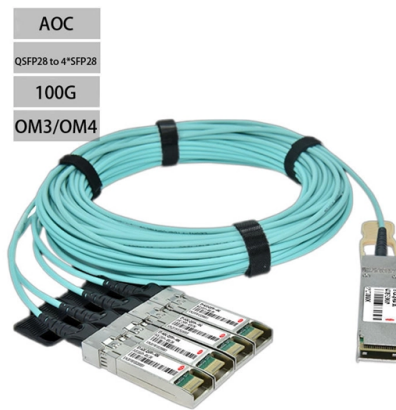

Labor costs vary from \$7 to \$50 per linear foot depending on soil conditions, terrain, and urban complexity. Trenching equipment rental can add \$200–\$500 per day, while directional boring rigs cost \$800–\$1,500 daily . Traffic control, safety measures, and urban permits can add \$1–\$10 per foot in busy areas . **Conduit and Accessories:** While direct burial can avoid conduit costs, some projects still use HDPE or PVC conduits for future expansion, adding \$2–\$4 per foot. Handholes, access vaults, and termination enclosures range from \$200–\$800 each . **Project Examples:** A typical 1,000-foot suburban project using conduit and directional boring can cost around \$35,000 (\$35 per foot). Underground installation is generally 40–60% more expensive than aerial deployment due to labor and equipment requirements .
