- Wall-mounted units: Approximately 400–600 mm width, 300–500 mm height, and 150–250 mm depth, suitable for small to medium installations.
- Floor-standing or larger panels: Widths of 800–1200 mm, heights of 1200–2000 mm, and depths of 300–600 mm, designed to house multiple modular DIN rail comp...
