A fiber pigtail is a short length of optical fiber that comes with a high-quality, factory-polished connector already installed on one end, leaving a length of exposed glass on the other. Mass Fusion Pigtails come with all 12 fibers terminated and a ribbonized. LC and SC form factor Fusion-Splice Connectors shall be TIA/ EIA-604 FOCIS-3 (for SC) and FOCIS-10 compatible (for LC), and include a pre-polished fiber which eliminates the need for field polishing and adhesives. The connectors shall be composed of a ferrule assembly with integral fiber, a front. They are the bridge between fiber optic cables in the field and the equipment or patch panels that manage them. Pre-routed and preloaded, pigtailed splice cassettes reduce installation time by up to 40%.
