

Distance requirements for cable tray fixing supports



Article Overview

Cable tray supports are typically spaced between 1.5 to 3 meters (5 to 10 feet) depending on tray type, load, and installation conditions.

Horizontal Support Spacing

For horizontal runs, the spacing between supports generally ranges from 1.5 meters to 3 meters (approximately 5 to 10 feet), depending on the tray type, cable weight, and manufacturer specifications . The NEC specifies that supports should not exceed 5 feet (1.5 meters) for standard installations, while ladder-type trays may allow slightly longer spans if designed for heavier loads . Supports should be installed at corners, bends, T-junctions, and tray ends to maintain stability .

Vertical and Angled Runs

For vertical or angled tray runs, supports should be fixed to the building structure at intervals preferably less than 2 meters (6.5 feet) to prevent sagging and ensure cable security . Additional supports may be required at transitions to equipment or other raceways if the unsupported span exceeds 6 feet (1.8 meters) .

Special Considerations

- Tray Type: Ladder trays, trough trays, and wire mesh trays have different load capacities, which affect support spacing
