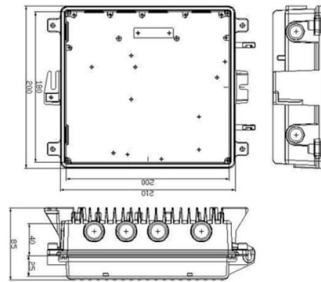


Distribution Box Diversion Markings

Purpose of Diversion Markings

Diversion markings on a distribution box serve to clearly indicate the destination or function of each circuit. This helps in quickly identifying which breaker controls a particular room, appliance, or equipment, reducing confusion during maintenance or emergencies and preventing accidental power interruptions or electrical hazards . Proper markings also ensure compliance with safety standards and facilitate troubleshooting.

Best Practices for Marking

- **Use Durable Labels:** Labels should be made from materials like vinyl or polyester to resist fading, peeling, or smudging over time .
- **Clear Descriptions:** Instead of generic terms like “Kitchen” or “Bedroom,” specify exact locations or devices, e.g., “Kitchen outlets east wall” or “Living room ceiling lights” .
- **Consistent Numbering:** Number breakers sequentially and match the numbers with a worksheet or digital record for easy reference .
- **Color Coding:** Some industrial or commercial setups use color-coded labels to indicate different voltage levels, critical circuits, or emergency power lines .
- **Update Regularly:** Whenever circuits are added, removed, or modified, update the markings to maintain accuracy
