Distribution boxes should be installed at ergonomic heights, in dry, accessible locations, with proper clearance for maintenance and safety.

Wall-Mounted Installation

For wall-mounted distribution boxes, the recommended height is typically 1.2 to 1.5 meters from the ground for the bottom of the enclosure, ensuring easy access for operation and maintenance . This height allows users to comfortably read labels, operate switches, and perform inspections without excessive bending or stretching . Outdoor wall-mounted boxes should be placed at least 3 feet (0.9 meters) above the ground to protect against water, dirt, and accidental impacts . Ensure the wall is dry, stable, and free from corrosive or flammable substances, and leave sufficient space around the box for ventilation and maintenance .

Ground-Mounted Installation

Ground-mounted distribution boxes should be raised 2 to 4 inches (5–10 cm) above the ground to prevent moisture damage and corrosion . For stainless steel enclosures, the bottom surface is often set between 1.3 and 1.5 meters above the ground for fixed units, considering ergonomic operation for routine maintenance . The installation site should be dry, well-ventilated, and easily accessible, with enough space for at least two people to work simultaneously. Avoid areas with strong vibrations, liquid splashes, heat sources, or corrosive gases
