When you build or upgrade a fiber network, the same four words pop up everywhere— fiber optic (bare fiber), pigtail, patch cord, optical cable. They're related, but they are not interchangeable. Despite representing less than 1% of total fiber infrastructure cost, they account for 30-40% of all fiber network faults in enterprise and data. The fibers need to have connectors fitted before they can attach to other equipment. Two common solutions for fiber cable termination are pigtails and fanout kits or breakout kits. You plug it into a switch, router, or patch panel.
