

Do you have a diagram on how to cut a 45-degree cable tray



Article Overview

To create a 45-degree bend in a cable tray, make two 22.5-degree miter cuts on separate tray sections, then join them to form the angle.

Step-by-Step Instructions

1. Measure and Mark the Cuts

- Draw a perpendicular line across the width of the cable tray.
- Using a protractor or angle finder, mark a 22.5-degree angle from this perpendicular line on the first tray section.
- Repeat for the second tray section, but mark the 22.5-degree cut in the opposite direction to allow the two pieces to join and form a 45-degree bend . 2. Prepare the Tray

- Ensure the tray is clean and free of debris.
- Wear safety glasses, gloves, and ear protection to prevent injury from metal shards or sparks . 3. Cutting Tools

- Use an angle grinder with a metal cutting disc, a band saw, or a circular saw suitable for metal.

- For thin trays, a band saw is preferred for precision and minimal burrs.
- Avoid using torches, as they can weaken the metal and damage surface coatings .

4. Make the Cuts

- Cut along the marked 22.5-degree lines carefully.
- Ensure the tray is securely clamped to prevent movement....
