Why Grounding is Necessary

Grounding a distribution box is essential for electrical safety. Metal enclosures can become live if a fault occurs, such as a loose wire touching the cabinet. Without a ground wire, anyone touching the box could receive an electric shock. Grounding also prevents static buildup and ensures that fault currents are safely directed to earth, protecting both personnel and equipment ().

Grounding Standards and Code Requirements

- NEC 250.148: Requires metallic junction boxes and cabinet doors to be bonded to ground using a designated grounding screw or clip ().
- NEC 314.28: Mandates that metal boxes must be reliably grounded and bonded.
- NEC 110.26: Ensures safe access to equipment doors without obstruction from wiring.
- Subpanels: Ground and neutral wires must remain separate in subpanels, with grounding conductors connected to a ground rod or grounding system ().

The grounding wire is generally required to be connected, but it is not connected on many occasions (such as construction site).

DISTRIBUTION BOX

Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. On the US market, a 5.26 mm² (10 AWG) ground wire

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
