Custom patch cables can be manufactured with specific fiber types (single-mode, multimode, polarization-maintaining, or specialty fibers) and connector configurations to meet application requirements . Proper connector installation is critical to minimize insertion loss and maintain signal integrity . 3. Cable Adaptation and Routing: Modifications may involve adjusting cable length, adding protective jackets, or rerouting fibers to accommodate network layout changes. Maintaining the minimum bend radius and avoiding excessive pulling or twisting is essential to prevent attenuation and physical damage .
