

Fiber distribution box fixing on pole



Article Overview

To fix a fiber distribution box on a pole, securely mount it using a pole bracket, manage cable slack, and ensure all fiber connections are clean and properly fastened.

Tools and Materials Needed

- Fiber distribution box and mounting bracket (e.g., YK-SX or FDH-HD compatible)
- Stainless steel bands and buckles
- Ratchet-strapping tool or banding tool
- Nylon ties
- Hammer and screws/bolts
- ADSS or mini ADSS fiber optic cable and drop cables
- Safety harness if working at height
- Fusion splicer, fiber cleaver, and cleaning kits for fiber connections

Installation Steps

- **Prepare the Pole and Bracket:** Attach the pole mount bracket to the pole using stainless steel bands or bolts, ensuring it is level and secure. Adjustable brackets like YK-SX allow for cable slack storage and fit most termination boxes .
- **Manage Cable Slack:** Coil the fiber optic cable neatly in the storage compartment of the bracket. Use nylon ties to secure the coil, maintaining a minimum bend radius (≥ 10 times the fiber diameter) to prevent damage .
- **Mount the Box:** Attach the fiber distribution box to the bracket using screws or bolts. For heavier cabinets, use a hoist or crane and ensure at least two people handle the box to avoid injury
