

Fiber optic cable broken in Mozambique



Article Overview

Mozambique experienced moderate internet disruptions due to failures in the SEACOM and EASSy submarine fiber optic cables, affecting connectivity across the country and neighboring regions.

Cause of the Interruption

The recent internet disruption in Mozambique was caused by damage to the SEACOM and EASSy submarine cable systems, which are critical for connecting Mozambique to the global internet via undersea fiber optic networks . The faults occurred on segments between Mozambique and South Africa, temporarily reducing internet speeds and partially compromising online services . These submarine cables transmit over 90% of international data traffic, making them essential for communication, streaming, and business operations .

Affected Areas

Mozambique experienced a moderate impact, while neighboring countries such as Malawi, Tanzania, Kenya, Zimbabwe, Eswatini, Uganda, and Rwanda also reported varying levels of disruption . Tanzania and the French island of Mayotte were the hardest hit, with severe connectivity losses . Some regions, like Nairobi in Kenya, experienced temporary outages, though redundancy measures helped restore partial service .
