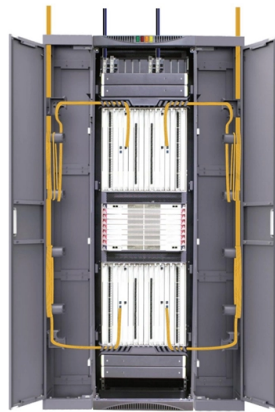


Fiber optic cable sagging and obstructing passage

Sagging fiber optic cables can pose both safety hazards and signal degradation, and should be corrected promptly using proper cable management and support techniques.

Causes of Sagging

Fiber optic cables may sag due to improper installation, excessive slack, environmental factors, or aging support structures. Over time, gravity, wind, or temperature changes can stretch or loosen aerial cables, causing them to droop into pathways. Sagging can also result from exceeding the cable's minimum bend radius, which may lead to macrobends where light leaks from the fiber core, reducing signal quality and potentially causing network outages .

Risks

- Physical obstruction: Sagging cables can block pedestrian walkways, roads, or equipment access, creating safety hazards.
- Signal degradation: Excessive bending or tension can cause attenuation, leading to slower speeds, intermittent connectivity, or complete signal loss .
- Cable damage: Prolonged sagging increases the risk of mechanical stress, microbends, or accidental breakage .
