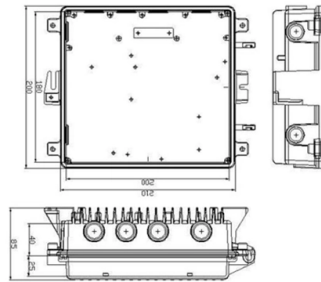


Fiber optic cable through pipe well



Article Overview

Fiber optic cables can be safely installed through pipes or wells using proper conduit, cable type, and installation techniques to ensure long-term reliability and protection.

Cable Selection

For underground or downhole applications, cable type is critical. Standard outdoor or indoor-outdoor fiber optic cables are suitable for pipelines, while permanent downhole cables use a tube-in-tube design with fibers in a hermetically sealed stainless steel or INCONEL tube, often filled with protective gels to prevent microbending and chemical ingress. These cables can withstand high pressure, elevated temperatures, mechanical shock, and corrosive fluids, making them ideal for wellbores.

Conduit and Innerduct

Fiber optic cables are typically installed in PVC or HDPE conduits buried underground or inside wells. Using innerducts within the conduit provides a smooth, continuous path and allows multiple cables to share a single conduit. The diameter ratio between the cable and innerduct should be optimized to reduce pulling tension and prevent damage. For existing pipelines or wells, multiple innerducts can be installed to allow future cable additions.
