They come in single-mode or multi-mode configurations, with single-core pigtails being standard for most enterprise applications and multi-fiber pigtails used in high-density data centers . Variants include indoor, armored, and waterproof pigtails depending on environmental requirements .

- Compatibility with single-mode or multi-mode fibers, depending on the application
