Galvanized flat steel is applied to cable trays to provide corrosion resistance, mechanical protection, and long-term durability, especially in outdoor or harsh environments.

Purpose and Benefits

Galvanized flat steel serves as a protective layer for cable trays, shielding the underlying steel from rust and oxidation. The zinc coating acts as a sacrificial barrier, preventing corrosion even if the surface is scratched or dented. This makes galvanized trays suitable for outdoor installations, industrial plants, and areas with high humidity or airborne chemicals. Properly produced hot-dip galvanized trays can last 25–50 years, depending on environmental conditions and maintenance.

Galvanization Processes

There are two main galvanization methods for cable trays:

- Electro-galvanization: Deposits a thin, uniform zinc layer via electrolysis. It provides moderate corrosion resistance and is generally used in less harsh environments.
- Hot-dip galvanization: Submerges steel in molten zinc, forming a thick zinc-iron alloy layer with excellent adhesion. This method offers superior corrosion protection and is preferred for outdoor, coastal, or industrial applications.
