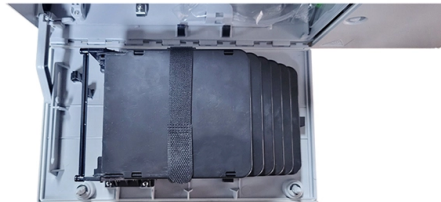


Global Fiber Optic Cable Line Length

Overview

The global fiber optic network forms the backbone of modern telecommunications, connecting continents, countries, and cities with high-speed data links. This network includes submarine cables that traverse oceans and terrestrial cables that link urban centers and data hubs across continents . Submarine cables alone, such as the FLAG system, can extend over 28,000 kilometers, connecting multiple countries across Europe, Asia, and North America . Modern undersea cables often exceed 100 terabits per second in capacity, using dense wavelength-division multiplexing (DWDM) to transmit multiple data streams simultaneously .

Global Scale

Industry estimates indicate that the total length of fiber optic cables worldwide exceeds 2.5 million kilometers, with a significant portion being terrestrial infrastructure supporting urban and rural connectivity . Submarine cables account for roughly 1.2 million kilometers, while terrestrial networks make up the remainder, linking data centers, internet exchange points, and last-mile connections . The network continues to expand rapidly due to growing demand from 5G, cloud computing, and data-intensive applications .
