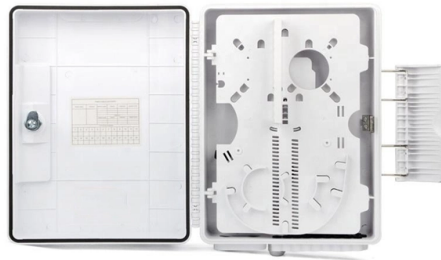


Ground wire terminal of main distribution box



Article Overview

In a main distribution box, the ground wire should be connected to the grounding busbar, which is bonded to the neutral busbar and the panel enclosure, providing a safe path for fault current.

Proper Connection

- **Locate the Grounding Busbar:** Open the main distribution box and identify the grounding bar, often marked as "PE" or with a green color. This is the designated terminal for all ground wires in the panel .
- **Connect the Ground Wire:** Use a copper conductor of appropriate size (commonly 4 AWG for residential service, or as specified by NEC Table 250.122). Strip the insulation for the required length, insert the wire into the terminal, and tighten the screw securely to ensure a firm connection .
- **Bonding with Neutral:** In the main panel, the neutral busbar must be bonded to the panel enclosure and the grounding busbar. This ensures that fault current has a single, low-resistance path back to the utility transformer, which is critical for activating breakers during a fault .
- **Grounding Electrode Connection:** The grounding busbar should be connected to the grounding electrode system, such as ground rods or a Ufer ground in the concrete foundation, to maintain effective grounding and safety .
