

How many holes should be installed in the socket of the distribution box

The number of socket holes (or outgoing circuits) in a distribution box depends on the load, protective devices, and space for future expansion, rather than a fixed number.

Determining Socket Holes

The suitable number of socket holes in a distribution box is influenced by several factors:

- 1. Load and Circuit Planning** Each socket-outlet circuit should be rated according to the expected load, typically 16 A for residential outlets, and should supply a reasonable number of sockets in series, considering wire gauge, voltage drop, and temperature rise effects on connections (1.5 mm² or 2.5 mm² conductors are common). High-load appliances like washing machines, dishwashers, or cookers should have dedicated circuits, not shared socket outlets.
- 2. Distribution Box Capacity** Distribution boxes are designed with a specific number of ways (slots) for protective devices such as MCBs, RCDs, or RCBOs. The number of socket holes corresponds to the number of outgoing circuits installed, plus spare ways for future expansion. For example, a 12-way box may accommodate 10 active circuits and 2 spare slots.
- 3. Standards and Safety Compliance** Installation must comply with local codes such as NEC, IEC 61439, or national standards. Each circuit should have its own protection device, and the internal layout must allow proper spacing, heat dissipation, and cable management. Overcrowding a box with too many circuits can compromise safety and violate code requirements.
