

How much copper can be extracted from an 8-core fiber optic cable used in smart buildings



Article Overview

Standard 8-core fiber optic cables contain little to no copper; any extractable copper comes only from hybrid designs with integrated metallic conductors.

Fiber Optic Cable Composition

Typical fiber optic cables are composed of:

- Core: Ultra-pure glass or plastic fibers transmitting data via light signals
 - Cladding: Reflective layer keeping light within the core
 - Buffer coating: Protective polymer layer
 - Strength members: Often aramid yarn or fiberglass for tensile strength
 - Outer jacket: Polyethylene, PVC, or low-smoke zero-halogen (LSZH) sheath
- Pure fiber optic cables do not contain copper; they rely entirely on light for data transmission, which eliminates the need for metallic conductors. This design provides immunity to electromagnetic interference and electrical isolation.
