

How to coil a junction box

Step-by-Step Guide to Coiling Wires in a Junction Box

1. Safety First Before handling any wires, turn off the circuit breaker and verify that the wires are de-energized using a non-contact voltage tester . Wear insulated gloves and use proper tools like wire strippers, pliers, and screwdrivers. 2. Prepare the Wires

- Strip the outer cable sheathing carefully without nicking the inner conductors.
- Leave 6-8 inches of wire protruding from the box to allow for splicing and coiling .
- Strip about $\frac{3}{4}$ inch of insulation from each conductor for proper connections. 3.

Make the Connections

- Ground wires first: Twist all bare or green wires together and secure with a wire nut. If using a metal box, attach a grounding pigtail to the box .
- Neutral wires: Connect all white wires together using wire nuts or pigtails.
- Hot wires: Connect black (or red) wires last, ensuring all splices are secure . 4. Coil the Wires

- After splicing, gently fold the wires into the box.
- Use a circular or figure-eight pattern to coil excess wire, keeping bundles compact but not overly tight.
- Avoid sharp bends or kinks, which can damage insulation or create stress points .
- Ensure that the wire nuts remain accessible and that no bare copper is exposed outside the connections. 5. Check Box Fill and Accessibility
- Verify that the box is not overcrowded. The National Electrical Code (NEC) specifie...
