Use Wall Mount Enclosures

Wall mount fiber optic enclosures are designed to house and protect fiber optic cables from dust, physical damage, and unauthorized access. These enclosures can be installed directly on walls in telecom rooms, data closets, or home offices, providing a compact and secure solution for fiber management . They typically include:

- Splice trays or adapter panels to connect incoming cables to pigtails or patch cords
 - Organized exit points for distributed cables
 - Lockable doors or covers to prevent tampering
- Choosing the right enclosure depends on the number of fiber strands, the type of connectors, and anticipated future expansion .

Wall Plates and Adapter Covers

For smaller installations or individual fiber connections, fiber wall plates can be used. These plates cover the wall opening and provide a neat interface for fiber connectors, often supporting multiple QUICKPORT connectors . They are ideal for home or office setups where a full enclosure may not be necessary.
