

How to move a fiber optic router to a different location

You can move a fiber optic router by either relocating the optical network terminal (ONT) with your provider's help or running an Ethernet cable from the ONT to a new router location.

Key Considerations

Fiber cables are fragile and have a minimum bend radius, so bending or stretching them can break the glass inside. This makes moving the ONT or fiber line yourself risky. In most cases, the safest approach is to keep the ONT in its original location and run a high-quality Ethernet cable to the new router location.

Steps to Move Your Router

- Plan the new location: Choose a central, elevated spot away from walls and obstructions to maximize Wi-Fi coverage.
- Check cabling options: If your home has Ethernet jacks, you can connect the router to the ONT via the nearest jack. If not, you may need to run a long Ethernet cable from the ONT to the new location.
- Use a network switch or access point: If you need multiple wired connections in the new room, connect a switch or configure a secondary router as an access point to expand ports.
- Power down and disconnect: Turn off the router and unplug all cables before moving.
- Connect and test: Plug the Ethernet cable into the router at the new location, con...
