

How to open the back cover of a network cabinet

To open the back cover of a network cabinet, you typically need to release hinge pins or screws, disengage any spring-loaded mechanisms, and lift or tilt the panel carefully while ensuring safety and equipment protection.

Step-by-Step Guide

1. Prepare the Cabinet

- Loosen or remove any screws or bolts securing the back panel to the cabinet frame.

- For hinged panels, ensure the operating handle is in the off position if the cabinet has an interlock mechanism .

4. Disengage Hinge Pins or Spring Mechanisms

- Pull the spring-loaded hinge pins at the top and bottom of the panel to release it from the frame .

- For split doors, remove the rear split doors first before attempting to remove side panels
