

How to route cables from cable trays to exposed cable ducts



Article Overview

Cables should be routed from trays to exposed ducts using smooth transitions, proper supports, and adherence to bend radius and separation standards to ensure safety and maintain signal integrity.

Planning the Transition

Before routing, plan the pathway from the cable tray to the exposed duct. Identify the entry and exit points, ensuring the path is as straight and short as possible to reduce stress on cables and maintain airflow in trays. Consider future expansion by leaving extra space in trays and ducts for additional cables .

Using Proper Supports

Use cable supports, brackets, or transition fittings to guide cables from the tray into the duct. This prevents sagging, mechanical damage, and accidental disconnections. Supports should be spaced according to the cable type and weight, following manufacturer recommendations and IEC 61537 standards .

Maintaining Bend Radius

Ensure that cables do not exceed their minimum bend radius when entering the duct. Sharp bends can damage insulation, reduce performance, and shorten cable life. Use elbows or radius control fittings at the tray-to-duct junction to maintain smooth curv...
