

How to set a fiber optic sensor to normally open and normally closed



Article Overview

You can switch a fiber optic sensor between normally open (NO) and normally closed (NC) modes using its configuration settings or teach-in function, depending on the sensor model.

Understanding NO and NC Modes

- **Normally Open (NO):** The sensor output is open (no current flows) when no object is detected and closes (current flows) when an object is detected .
- **Normally Closed (NC):** The sensor output is closed (current flows) when no object is detected and opens (no current flows) when an object is detected . The choice between NO and NC depends on your system requirements and how you want the sensor to interact with the control module.

Methods to Adjust NO/NC State

- **Using Sensor Buttons or Teach-In Function** Many fiber optic sensors, such as the Wenglor OPT2041, allow you to toggle between NO and NC modes via a teach-in function or control panel buttons. This function also lets you adjust the sensing range to ensure accurate detection . Typically, you follow these steps:
 - Enter the teach-in mode using the designated button or input.
 - Select the desired output mode (NO or NC).
 - Confirm the setting and exit teach-in mode.
