

How to splice pigtails to optical fibers

Splicing bundled pigtails to optical fibers is best done using fusion splicing with proper preparation, cleaning, and protection to ensure low-loss, reliable connections.

Tools and Materials Needed

- Fusion Splicer: Creates a permanent, low-loss joint by melting fiber ends together .
- Fiber Strippers: Remove the outer jacket and coating without damaging the glass core .
- High-Precision Cleaver: Cuts the fiber at a perfect 90-degree angle for optimal fusion .
- Cleaning Supplies: Lint-free wipes and 99% isopropyl alcohol to remove debris and oils .
- Heat-Shrink Splice Protection Sleeves: Protect the fragile splice after fusion .
- Bundled Pigtails: Multi-strand pigtails (12-strand, 24-strand, etc.) pre-terminated on one end .

Step-by-Step Fusion Splicing Process

- Prepare the Fiber: Strip the outer jacket and coating from both the incoming fiber bundle and the pigtail fibers using fiber strippers. Clean each fiber until it “squeaks” when rubbed with lint-free wipes .
- Cleaving: Use a high-precision cleaver to cut the fiber ends at a perfect 90-degree angle. This ensures a smooth surface for fusion .
- Insert Splice Protection Sleeve: Slide a heat-shrink sleeve onto the pigtail before splicing to protect the joint afterward .
- Fusion Splicing: Place the prepared fibers into the fusion splicer. The splicer aligns...
