

How to turn a pigtail into a network cable

- Strip and Clean the Fiber: Remove the protective coating from the bare fiber carefully without nicking the glass core.
- Splice the Fiber: Use a fusion splicer to join the bare end of the pigtail to the incoming fiber. This creates a low-loss, permanent connection.
- Test the Connection: Verify signal integrity using an optical power meter or OTDR to ensure minimal loss.
- Connect the Factory-End: Plug the connector end into your patch panel, ODF, or network device.
