

IP address of the switch s fiber optic port



Article Overview

Fiber optic ports on a switch do not have individual IP addresses; the switch's management IP address is used to access and configure all ports, including fiber ports.

Understanding Fiber Port IPs

Fiber optic ports themselves are layer 1 interfaces and do not possess independent IP addresses. Instead, the switch has a single management IP address that allows administrators to log in and configure all ports, including fiber SFP or SFP+ ports . This IP address is typically assigned to the switch's management VLAN or default VLAN.

How to Find the Switch Management IP

- Check the switch documentation or label: Many switches, like MikroTik FiberBox, have a default IP (e.g., 192.168.88.1) for initial configuration .
- Use network discovery tools: Utilities like AXIS IP Utility or Winbox can detect the switch on the network and display its IP address .
- Console access: Connect via the console port (RJ45 or USB) and log in to the switch. Commands like `show running-config` or `show ip interface brief` on Cisco switches will display the management IP .
