The recommended installation height for distribution boxes is generally between 1.4 to 1.7 meters (4.5 to 5.5 feet) from the finished floor, ensuring accessibility, safety, and compliance with standards.

Recommended Heights

- **Residential Indoor Installations:** Mount the distribution box at 1.4 to 1.7 meters from the floor for easy access without bending or stretching excessively. For elderly or disabled users, a slightly lower height of around 1.3 meters is suggested to improve accessibility .
- **Outdoor Installations:** Place the box at least 3 feet (0.9 meters) above ground to protect against water, dirt, and accidental impacts .
- **Ground-Mounted Boxes:** Raise the box 2 to 4 inches above the floor to prevent moisture damage .
- **Industrial Settings:** Heights may vary depending on equipment layout, but typical mounting areas for IP54-rated panels are up to 1.2 meters high, with adequate clearance for safe operation and maintenance .

- **Accessibility:** Ensure the box is reachable for routine inspections, maintenance, and emergency access without strain .
- **Safety:** Avoid wet areas, direct water exposure, and locations prone to mechanical...
