Key Differences

ONU (Optical Network Unit): An ONU is a terminal device in a fiber-to-the-home (FTTH) or fiber-to-the-building network. It connects directly to the Optical Line Terminal (OLT) at the service provider's central office and converts optical signals into electrical signals for end-user devices like routers, computers, and phones. ONUs operate primarily at Layer 1 and Layer 2 (physical and data link layers) and are designed to serve as the endpoint of a passive optical network (PON), handling signal conversion and basic data forwarding within the user premises .

All-Optical Switch: An all-optical switch is a network switch whose ports are entirely optical, meaning it forwards data without converting optical signals to electrical signals. It is typically deployed in high-performance networks, such as data centers or enterprise backbones, to maintain end-to-end optical transmission, reduce latency, and avoid signal degradation. All-optical switches operate at the network switching level, managing traffic between multiple optical links rather than serving as a terminal for end-user devices .
