This makes it ideal for FTTH (Fiber to the Home) deployments, where the fiber runs from the service provider's central office directly to the residence . Single-mode fiber is generally used for the “last mile” because it can carry high-bandwidth signals over several kilometers without degradation . Multimode fiber, on the other hand, has a larger core that allows multiple light modes to propagate simultaneously. It is cost-effective and easier to install for short distances, typically under a few hundred meters, such as within a home or building for internal LAN connections . Multimode fiber is commonly used in enterprise networks, data centers, or campus environments, but it is less common for the main fiber run to a home because its distance limitations and modal dispersion make it less suitable for long runs .

Practical Use in Homes

- FTTH deployments almost always use single-mode fiber from the provider to the home due to its long-distance capability and high bandwidth
